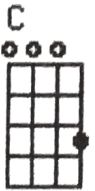


Hallelujah

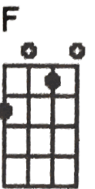

Chorus: Halle-lujah, halle-lujah, halle-lujah, halle-lu-u-u-u-jah



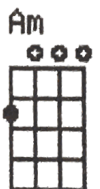
C Am C Am
