Yeah, I'm going to [F] Jackson. [G7] Goodbye, that's all she [C] wrote

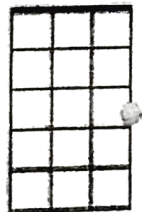
VERSE 4: (ladies sing)

And I'll be waitin' in [F] Jackson, [G7] behind my Japan [C] fan

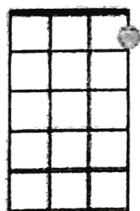
VERSE 5: (together)

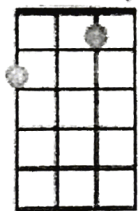
